Dr Alan Billings is the South Yorkshire Police and Crime Commissioner. It is his job to give the public a say in how they wish to be policed and produce a strategic South Yorkshire Police and Crime Plan, setting out the priorities for the South Yorkshire Police. As part of the Commissioner's plan PTSG won the contract to deliver a programme of fire door replacements and upgrade works.

PTSG carried out a programme of fire protection works including fire door replacements/ upgrades, works to remedy breaches to compartmentation lines including fire stopping, and penetration sealing systems on 50 security-sensitive buildings at various locations in the South Yorkshire Policing District.

We worked closely with the client throughout the COVID-19 pandemic to provide maximum office space for reduced staff numbers throughout the duration of the project.

Works were released in batches of five sites per month on a priority basis. To keep disruption to a minimum, works were undertaken through a programme of night-time and weekend working patterns.

Due to the security sensitive nature of operations, rigid vetting and data exchange protocol was essential. Stringent management of the fire stopping, joinery, mechanical and electrical teams as well as strict performance specifications, handover and commissioning procedures were required to reach full compliance with SYPCC protocols and FIRAS certification standards.
